Blue Wristbands - Everyone coming on Camp Eagle property will receive one of these at the front gate. They let us know you've signed your waiver and cover your **land access fee** - giving you access to the waterfront, kayaks, sports courts, and guest wifi. Non-racers must purchase these for \$10. Racers are covered by the swell folks at Too Cool Racing. Children 3 & under are free.

Green Wristbands - These are for the legendary **Zip 3000.** One wristband gets you one ride on the Zip & costs \$20. Sign-up sheets will be in the main office foyer, where you can also pay for your wristband.

Pink Wristbands - These grant access to all the other activities we'll be offering throughout the weekend, specifically the Zip 850, Rock Climbing Wall, Rappel Wall, and Ore Chute & Underground Maze in the Nueces Canyon Mine. They cost \$10 a pop and can be purchased in the main office foyer.

Camp Eagle Day Camp - We' II have our stellar summer staff offering a day camp experience for your kids Saturday from 8:45am - 3:00pm. The cost is \$15, lunch is included, and we'll be accepting kids ages 5-12. Sign up & pay in the pavilion Saturday morning or online during registration.

Friday Dinner & Sunday Breakfast - Are both covered by the sweet crew at

Too Cool Racing for racers. Nonracers will need to purchase meals on their own. All meals will take place in the dining lodge or at the pavilion and can be purchased at the meal venue.

General Do's & Don'ts -

Do respect the property, relax, have fun, ask any questions you may have to a staff member, use the walkie talkie in the office foyer to reach a staffer for late-night emergencies, and ultimately have the best weekend EVER.

Important Camp Eagle Information

• Please **fill up on gas** well before arriving at Camp Eagle. The nearest reliable gas station is over an hour away.

• Wifi is available at the main office; We do not have cell service.

• Unless you're staying in the Trinity building, you must **bring your own bedding & towels.**

• Dogs, or any other pets, are not allowed on Camp Eagle property. (unless

they are a service animal)

• We **do not allow smoking** inside our rooms. Smoking outside on the grounds is allowed.

• RV (non-hook up) & Tent **Camping costs \$5 per person per night.** This is payable at the front gate through cash or card. Too Cool covers racers camping fee.

• Everyone ages 4 & up must pay a one-time, **\$10 land access fee** upon arrival. Too

Cool covers this fee for all racers!

• If you're camping in the RV/Tent field, feel free to use any of the bathrooms around main camp or

at the barn. If you'd like to shower, follow signs to the bathhouse by the screen shelters. Check our

online booking if you're interested in an RV Hookup (limited availability)

• We do not allow ground fires. Camp stoves, however, are allowed.

• Please be moved out of your rooms by 10:30 am Monday.

• Meals will be available throughout the weekend from Camp Eagle and can be paid for with cash or card.

• If you're in urgent need of assistance and can't find a staff member, go to the office foyer, use the walkie beneath the TV, and ask for Hailee. She'll be there to help in a few minutes.

• Helmets must be worn anytime you're on your bike.

• Please do not get on any high elements or participate in any Camp Eagle activities without the permission & supervision of a Camp Eagle staff member.
