### Camp Eagle Activities Offered

- Waterfront will be offered daily for free to all guests staying on CE property who have paid the one-time \$10 land access fee. Waterfront will be open 10-12 and 1-6 Saturday and Sunday. Kayaks will be open all weekend. We require life jackets and there will be sanitizer there for guests to use on the kayaks. We will have someone sanitize the kayaks each afternoon as well.
- With the purchase of an activity band (\$15) guests will be able to enjoy the 850 ft zipline and rock-climbing Saturday and Sunday from 3-6 pm.
- Guests may also purchase one ride on the 3000 ft. zip line with the purchase of a Z3K wristband for \$20. These rides are offered at 4:30 pm on Saturday and Sunday and spots are limited.

\*\*\*Due to COVID-19 protocol, all guests participating in a harnessed activity will have to check out their harness from our gear room and leave some form of collateral (DL or CC) with our quartermaster to ensure the harness is well taken care of while checked out and returned after the activity is over\*\*\*

**Activity bands and z3k bands will be sold at the front gate and in the coffee shop throughout the weekend. Ice will be sold out of the coffee shop.**

### Too Cool Activities Offered

**-Orienteering Course 7am Saturday-noon Sunday:** We have set an orienteering course on property. Preplotted maps will be available beginning 7 am Saturday morning in front of our room, upstairs in the Trinity building. Competitive folks will need to start and stop their Strava from the Trinity then upload to their social media (FB, IG both) and tag Too Cool Racing. Prizes will be given out at happy hour on Sunday. Please note, you will need a compass and the ability to carry water.

**-Orienteering class 9 am Saturday:** We will lead a very basic class on map and compass. Meet in front of the Trinity building.

**-Group bike ride 10 am Saturday:** This is a no-drop social distance ride out to the Zebra property. Approx. 10-15 miles, beginner-intermediate. Midway point will have snacks, water.

**-Movie Night 8:30 pm Saturday:** Meet in the pavilion for the classic camp movie 'Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>'. Kettle corn and drinks will be available for purchase.

**-Happy Hour 5 pm Sunday:** Happy hour sponsored by our friends over at [Last Stand Brewing](#). Meet at big lawn by firepit for a socially distanced happy hour.

**-Scavenger Hunt 7 pm Sunday:** Pick up clue sheets in front of Trinity building and head out to find clues around camp. You will be required to take photos (no touch scavenger hunt) of things around camp so keep your eyes peeled all weekend for interesting camp stuff!!

### Meals

We will be serving meals from Friday dinner through Monday lunch. Guests have the option to purchase all meals upfront for \$65/ person. Or you can purchase them individually at mealtimes.

- Breakfast will be \$6/ person.
- Lunch will be \$7/ person.
- Dinner will be \$8/ person.

- Lunch: Saturday - Monday, 11:30 am - 1 pm

### General Do's & Don'ts -

**Do** respect the property, relax, have fun, ask any questions you may have to a staff member, use the walkie talkie in the office foyer to reach a staffer for late-night emergencies, and ultimately have the best weekend EVER.

**Don't bring** your pets, light ground fires, ride bikes without helmets, or smoke in your room.

**Payment** - Everything at Camp Eagle can be purchased with cash, card, or check.

### Important Camp Eagle Information

- Please **fill up on gas** well before arriving at Camp Eagle. The nearest reliable gas station is over an hour away.
- Wifi is available at the main office; **We do not have cell service.**
- Unless you're staying in the Trinity building, you must **bring your own bedding & towels.**
- **Dogs** or any other pets, **are not allowed** on Camp Eagle property. (unless they are a service animal)
- We **do not allow smoking** inside our rooms. Smoking outside on the grounds is allowed.
- Everyone ages 4 & up must pay a one-time, **\$10 land access fee** upon arrival.

- If you're camping in the RV/Tent field, feel free to use any of the bathrooms around main camp or at the barn. If you'd like to shower, follow signs to the bathhouse by the screen shelters. Check our online booking if you're interested in an RV Hookup (limited availability)
- We do not allow ground fires. Camp stoves, however, are allowed.
- Please be moved out of your rooms by 11 am Monday.
- Meals will be available throughout the weekend from Camp Eagle and can be paid for with cash or card.
- If you're in urgent need of assistance and can't find a staff member, go to the office foyer, use the walkie beneath the TV, and ask for Hailee. She'll be there to help in a few minutes.
- **Helmets must be worn anytime you're on your bike.**
- Please do not get on any high elements or participate in any Camp Eagle activities without the permission & supervision of a Camp Eagle staff member.
- If you have any questions, stop by the office or ask anyone in a staff shirt. We're glad to help

### **COVID-19 Precautions**

- We will ask people to do their own [10-day pre-screening](#) before arrival
- We ask that people lodge only with those from their own household
- There will be a non-invasive health screening upon arrival and on entry to any retail or dining location.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be served out of the coffee shop to be enjoyed in the outdoors
- Dinners will be served out of the dining hall but guests will be asked to enjoy their meal outdoors
