# Activity / General Information

***Meals - Dining hall meal tickets MUST be purchased at The Nest. All meals will be served out of our Dining Lodge.***

**Green Wristbands** - Everyone coming on Camp Eagle property will receive one of these at the front gate. They let us know you've signed your waiver and cover your **land access fee** - giving you access to the waterfront, kayaks, sports courts, and guest wifi. Non-racers must purchase these for \$10. Racers are covered by the swell folks at Too Cool Racing. Children 3 & under are free.

**Orange Wristbands** - These are for the legendary **Zip 3000**. One wristband gets you one ride on the Zip & costs \$20. Sign up sheets will be in The Nest or online, where you can also pay for your wristband. Meet @The Nest (Coffee shop) patio.

**Pink Wristbands** - These grant access to all the other activities we'll be offering throughout the weekend, specifically the Zip 850, Rock Climbing Wall, Rappel Wall, Ore Chute & Underground Maze in the Nueces Canyon Mine. They cost \$10/person and may be purchased at The Nest or online.

**Camp Eagle Day Camp** - We'll have our stellar summer staff offering a day camp experience for your kids Saturday from 7:45am - 3:00pm. The cost is \$20, lunch is included, and we'll be accepting kids ages 5-12. You can sign up and pay online or in the coffee shop (the Nest).

**Friday Dinner & Sunday Breakfast** - Are both covered by the sweet crew at Too Cool Racing for racers. Non-racers will need to purchase meals on their own. All meals will take place in the dining lodge and meals or tickets will be purchased @ The Nest (coffee shop).

***Meals - Breakfast & Lunch will be served out of The Dining Hall. Dinner will be served out of our Dining hall but tickets NEED to be purchased at The Nest.***

- **DO NOT Cross the river. That is not our property.**
- Wifi is available at the main office, dining hall, and the Nest. There is a landline in the office foyer
- **Dogs**, or any other pets, **are not allowed** on Camp Eagle property. (unless they are a licensed service animal)
- We **do not allow smoking** inside our rooms. Smoking outside on the grounds is allowed.
- If you're camping in the RV/Tent field, feel free to use any of the bathrooms around the main camp or at the barn. If you'd like to shower, follow signs to the bathhouse by the screen shelters.
- **WE ARE UNDER A STRICT BURN BAN! Please, propane or covered grills only.**
- **Please be moved out of your rooms by 10:30 am Monday.**
- Meals will be available throughout the weekend from Camp Eagle and can be paid for with cash or card.
- If you're in urgent need of assistance and can't find a staff member, go to the office foyer, use the walkie beneath the TV, and ask for Hailee. She'll be there to help in a few minutes.
- **Helmets must be worn anytime you're on your bike.**
- Please do not get on any high elements or participate in any Camp Eagle activities without the permission & supervision of a Camp Eagle staff member.
